Shirt Comments

I FOUND THE SHIRTS TO UNCOMFORTABLE TO WEAR.

1. I DISAGREE WITH THE STUD FASTENING DUE TO THE FACT WHEN YOU'VE IRONED THEM IT SHOWS UP MARKS ON THE SHIRT AND ALSO IF A STUD CAME OFF THE SHIRT WOULD NO LONGER BE WEARABLE.
2. THE SHIRT WAS VERY HARD TO IRON AND TOOK TOO LONG SO IT MEANT THAT SOMETIMES I HAD TO WEAR THE OLD STYLE SHIRTS.
3. OVERALL I WOULD NOT WEAR THE SHIRT DUE TO THE FACT WHEN IT GOT HOT THE SHIRT GETS HOT AND THE SHIRT BECOMES WET AND STAYS WET WHICH I FIND VERY DISGUSTING.
4. DUE TO THE AMOUNT OF WASHING OF THE SHIRT THE SHIRT NOW LOOKS TATTY AND VERY CHEAP LOOKING.

I DID FIND THE SHIRTS VERY GOOD AND LIGHT TO WEAR BUT AGAIN DID NOT HAVE THE CORRECT SIZE. I ALSO FOUND WHEN IRONING THE STUDS COME THROUGH AND THE QUALITY OF THE BADGES WERE NOT, I FELT, OF A GOOD STANDARD OF STITCHING.

BADGES STARTED FALLING TO BITS ON LEFT ARM. LAS ON BACK OF SHIRT IS DIFFICULT TO IRON

LOTS OF PEOPLE LIKED THE NHS LOGO BADGE BUT IT WOULD BE BETTER OPPOSITE THE CROWN BADGE ABOVE THE RIGHT BREAST POCKET.
THE OVERALL EMBROIDERY QUALITY WAS VERY POOR - EVEN AFTER A FEW WEARS THE 'NEW' LAS BADGE ON THE ARMS WAS BEGINNING TO UNPICK AND BECAME VERY TATTY.
NO BADGES ON THE ARMS! IT MAKES IT HARDER TO IRON AND IS A BIT OF OVERKILL WITH THE LAS NAME ON THE FRONT/BACK SHOULDERS.
PREFERRED THE OLD STYLE EMBROIDERED LAS CREST ON ITS OWN. LIKED THE NEW NHS BADGE A LOT.

MESH UNDER ARMS TOO BIG - CAN SEE BRA IF NO T-SHIRT IS WORN
POPPERS NOT STRONG ENOUGH
FORCED TO WEAR T-SHIRT IN CASE SOMEONE GRABS SHIRT
EMBROIDERY ON BACK OF SHIRT CRINKLES BADLY IN WASH
IMPOSSIBLE TO IRON. STRAIGHTEN OUT

ISSUED SHIRTS ARE RIDICULOUSLY LARGE. SEEM TO ISSUED ON A SMALL, MEDIUM & LARGE BASIS. A RETURN TO STANDARD SIZES WOULD BE AN IMPROVEMENT. AS A RESULT OF BEING FAR TOO BIG, THE SHIRT WAS UNCOMFORTABLE AND HOT. MANY FEMALE STAFF VERY CONCERNED REGARDING POPPERS BEING PULLED OPEN BY PATIENTS

COULD WE LOOSE THE EPILEPTIC & HAVE 'PARAMEDIC' OR 'TECHNICIAN' ABOVE RIGHT POCKETS

THE SHIRTS SEEMED TO HAVE AN AMERICAN CUT, I PREFER THE CUT OF THE SHIRTS THAT ARE ON ISSUE NOW. THE UNDERARM VENTS ARE A GOOD IDEA BUT SHOULD NOT BE SEE THROUGH. I LIKED THE DARKER GREEN. THE POPPER STUDS ARE A POOR IDEA.

SHIRTS ARE POOR QUALITY MATERIAL. BADGES ON THE SLEEVES MAKE THE SHIRT DIFFICULT TO IRON AND GIVE A CHEAP APPEARANCE. I LIKE THE IDEA OF THE 'NHS' LOGO - PUT IT ABOVE THE RIGHT POCKET. THE MESH MATERIAL NEEDS TO BE OPAQUE.

I COULD ONLY COMMENT ON THE SHORT PROVIDED WHICH WERE FAR TOO BIG. THE MESH UNDER THE ARMS IS A GOOD IDEA BUT WOMEN WON'T BE ABLE TO WEAR THE SHIRTS WITHOUT A T-SHIRT MAKING THEM EXTREMELY HOT TO WEAR PARTICULARLY IN THE SUMMER. THE SHIRTS WERE A LITTLE HEAVY ON MATERIAL FOR ALL YEAR ROUND.

IRONING THE EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK OF THE SHIRTS WAS HARD.
THE EMBROIDERY IS OF POOR QUALITY, LOOKED VERY WORN QUICKLY, THE BADGES HAVE STARTED TO BECOME DETACHED FROM THE SHIRT.
THE MESH UNDER THE ARMS MAKES IT DIFFICULT FOR WOMEN NOT TO WEAR A T-SHIRT AS THE ARMS/SLEEVES OF SHIRTS ARE TOO BIG AND WIDE.
THE MESH SERVES NO PURPOSE AND IS OF NO BENEFIT TO THE WEARER.
PEOPLE DISLIKED THE POCKET FLAPS BEING AT A SLANT.
THE EMBROIDERY AT THE BACK OF THE SHIRTS WAS IRRITATING WHEN YOU DID NOT WEAR A T-SHIRT.

IF THERE IS A NEED FOR NHS LOGO WHY NOT ABOVE RIGHT POCKET.
ANYBADGES ON SLEEVES MAKES IRONING DIFFICULT.
WRONG TYPE OF MATERIAL, AFTER WASHING DRIP DRYING CREASES REMAIN - WON'T DROP OUT.
ONE SHIRT RECEIVED WITH POPPER ALREADY TORN OUT OF FABRIC

Shirt Comments

SHIRTS VERY BAGGY, LENGTH OK, PLASTICEY LIKE THE TROUSERS, EMBROIDED BADGE VERY POOR QUALITY AND LETTERING ON BACK DIFFERENT SIZES AND FRAYING AFTER 6 WASHES. COLLARS DIFFICULT TO IRON AND WONT HOLD SHAPE. I DON'T NORMALLY WEAR LONG SLEEVES SHIRTS BUT DID TRY THEM FOR 1 SET OF SHIFTS. SOME OF THE LAS SLEEVE BADGES ARE ALSO STARTING TO FRAY

POOR QUAILTY EMBRODIERY AND BADGES.
CREST OVER THE LEFT POCKET SHOULD BE MADE LARGER TO IMPROVE DETAIL, EITHER MOVING THE LAS WORDING TO ABOVE THE RIGHT POCKET OR DELETING ALTOGETHER.
THE POCKET FLAPS SHOULD BE STRAIGHT - NOT ANGLED

ALL OF THE EMBRODIERY AND BADGES SHRUNK IN THE WASH, DISTORTING THE SHIRTS AND MADE THEM LOOK SHABBY AND DIFFICULT TO IRON. ALSO THE ROYAL CREST WAS TOTALLY ILLEGIBLE

THE EPANLEBBES ARE TOO FAR OVER THE BACK OF THE SHOULDER.
HE BADGES AND EMBROIDERY MAKE THE SHIRT VERY DIFFICULT TO IRON, EPESICALLY THE EMBRODIERY ON THE REAR WHICH ENDS UP IN A CRUMPLED BALL AFTER WASHIGN AND TUMBLE DRYING THE SHIRT.
WHY DO LONG SLEEVE SHIRTS - FOR COLDER WEATHER - HAVE ARMPIT VENTS?
WHY PRESS STUDS? WHEN 1 GOES THE SHIRT HAS TO BE THROWN AWAY UNLIKE BUTTONS THAT CAN BE SEWN BACK ON, THEY ARE ALSO PAINFUL TO CLOSE ON THE CHEST POCKET.
ALSO PRESS STUDS AND ARMPIT VENTS MEAN THAT FEMALE STAFF WILL HAVE TO WEAR T-SHIRTS AT ALL TIMES.

WHILST THE EMBROIDERY IS A GOOD IDEA ON THE SHIRT BACK THE CURRENT EMBROIDERY IS NOT UP TO STANDRAD. A NHS LOGO UNDER THE FRONT OF THE LAS BADGE WOULD BE LESS OBTRUSIVE.

DUE TO THE WEIGHT OF THE MATERIAL IT WAS TOO HOT TO WEAR A TSHIRT. DUE TO THE FACT THE SHIRT HAS POP STUDS THEY COULD EASILY COME UNDONE WHICH IS OBVIOUSLY A WORRY. I WOULD RATHER THE SHIRT WAS MUCH LIGHTER AND HAVE BUTTONS.
THE SHORT SLEEVE SHIRTS SLEEVES ARE FAR TOO WIDE, ENABLING PEOPLE TO SEE UP MY SLEEVE

EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK OF THE SHIRT IS ESSENTIAL AS WE NEED TO BE EASILY RECOGNSIABLE.
SHIRTS ARE TOO HOT

LAS EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK LOOKS OUT OF PLACE AND NOT REQUIRED.

ON THE BREAST, IF THE BADGE WERE THE SAME AS THE CURRENT UNIFORM THE WORDS BENEATH WOULD NOT BE REQUIRED AS YOU CAN READ LONDON AMUBULANCE SERVICE IN THE CREST

THE COLLAR WAS POOR. IT WAS HARD TO IRON IT SO THAT IT LOOKED RIGHT.

SHIRT MATERIAL HEAVIER THAN OLD SHIRTS.
SLIGHTLY ITCHY AND WARM
EMBROIDERY BAD QUALITY
STUDS ARE INSECURE
FABRIC MESH TOO REVEALING FOR FEMALES

STITCHING TENDS TO SHRINK A LITTLE

EMBROIDERY SHRUNK
UNCOMFORTABLE

PREFER LOGO ON BACK
LOGO ON SLEEVES ARE TOO MUCH AND NUSCIENCE TO IRON
COLOUR IS GOOD

EMBROIDERY QUALITY POOR

LIGHTER GREEN COLOUR WANTED
TOO HOT IN SUMMER

MOST OF THE FEEDBACK FROM MOST OF THE CREWS THAT I HAVE SPOKEN TOO DO NOT LIKE THE EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK OF THE SHIRT, BUT I DON'T MIND EITHER

EMBROIDERY SHRUNK AND DIFFICULT TO IRON

MESH UNDER ARMS IS BAD AS BRA CAN BE SEEN IF NOT WEARING A T-SHIRT

POPPERS ARE GOOD BUT PEOPLE ARE WORRIED THAT THEY CAN BE RIPPED OPENED EASILY

Shirt Comments

EMBROIDERY ON BACK OF SHIRT CAN SCRATCH THE SKIN

SHIRT TAIL NOT LONG ENOUGH

EMBROIDERY ON THE BADGES & BACK OF SHIRTS COULD BE BETTER.

BADGE ON FRONT, COMPLETELY UNREADABLE. BADGE ON SLEEVE BEGINNING TO FRAY. WRITING ON BACK COMING UNDONE.

STUDS COME OFF SHIRTS, COLOUR FADED AFTER SEVERAL WASHES.

EMBROIDERY QUALITY VERY POOR. AFTER WASHING BECOMES MISSHAPEN.
LOGO'S ARE ALSO OF VERY POOR QUALITY.
NOT STITCHED FLUSH, DIFFICULT TO IRON.
THE ONLY BADGE REQUIRED IS THE LEFT CHEST LAS LOGO, EVEN THIS IS DIFFICULT TO IRON WHEN WASHED. LOOKS CHEAP.
QUALITY OF FABRIC AND COLOUR GOOD

SHIRTS NOT LONG ENOUGH IN TRUNK
SHIRT POPPER SEAM HAS EXTRA WIDTH MATERIAL CAUSING IRON MARKS DOWN FRONT OF SHIRT
DIFFICULT TO IRON
PUT NHS LOGO JUST ABOVE RIGHT SIDE POCKET INSTEAD OF ON SLEEVE OR ON FLAP OF RIGHT SIDE POCKET
BADGES WEARING AWAY
MATERIAL TOO THICK FOR SUMMER

EXCELLENT IN DARKER GREEN, PROFESSIONAL, BUT NEED TO BE LONGER AND DOES NOT NEED SLITS ON THE SIDES AS THEY BECOME UNTUCKED.
LAS LOGO ON BACK IS UNCOMFORTABLE WITHOUT T-SHIRT.

SHIRTS COULD BE AVAILABLE IN TWO LENGTHS AS THEY ARE EXTRA LONG

EMBROIDERY STARTING TO COME OFF AND SHRUNK
BADGES COMING OFF
SHIRTS TOO BIG

PEN HOLDER ON LEFT ARM WOULD BE NICE

SHIRTS TOO SHORT IN LENGTH
BAD EMBROIDERY

STUDS ON THE SHIRT SHOW AFTER YOU IRON THEM
IF YOU DON'T WEAR A TSHIRT AND YOUR SHIRTS GET PULLED - NOT GOOD IF YOUR FEMALE

BAD EMBROIDERY
ONE LOGO NEEDED - WHICH INCORPORATES EVERYTHING
OFFICERS IN WHITE

LENGTH OF SHIRTS TOO SHORT
SLEEVES TOO BIG
WHEN IRONING STUDS SHOWED THROUGH FABRIC

STUDS LEAVE MARK IN FABRIC WHEN IRONED
TOO MANY BADGES OR LOGOS

BAD EMBROIDERY
SHRUNK WHEN WASHED
SHIRTS VERY BIG

SHIRT TOO SHORT
BAD EMBROIDERY
PEN POCKET ON SHIRT WANTED

EMBROIDERY IS BAD QUALITY
SHRUNK WHEN WASHED
LOGO NOT NEEDED ON FRONT AND SLEEVE
SLANTING POCKETS LOOK DAFT

Shirt Comments

BADGES MAKE IRONING DIFFICULT
NO NEED FOR BADGE ON LEFT SLEEVE
EMBROIDERY IS TERRIBLE QUALITY

I LIKE THE STYLE OF THE SHIRT WITH THE OPEN COLLAR (BUT WITHOUT THE LOGO ON THE BACK)

SHIRTS TOO SHORT BY FAR
CAN SEE STUD MARKS AFTER IRONING
HARD TO IRON

EMBROIDERY SHRUNK AND POOR QUALITY

SHIRT SLEEVES ARE TOO WIDE

I FOUND THE EMBROIDERY ON THE SHIRTS OF VERY POOR QUALITY. ON THE BACK I WOULD HAVE TO IRON ON A MAXIMUM TO GET IT REASONABLY FLAT AFTER A WASH. THIS IS CONTRARY TO THE IRONING INSTRUCTIONS, THE LAS LOGO ON THE FRONT IS BLURRED WITH EXTRA BITS OF COTTON OVER IT. STUDS BEGAN TO SHOW THROUGH ON IRONING EVEN THOUGH THEY WERE HIDDEN.

INSTEAD OF EMBROIDERED BADGE ON LEFT CHEST, WHY NOT USE WOVEN BADGES INSTEAD. EMBROIDERY DIFFICULT TO IRON AS IT SHRINKS WHEN WASHED CAUSING A "PULLING EFFECT" ON THE SHIRT.

THE SHIRTS ARE OBVIOUSLY UNISEX. THE SHOULDERS FELL OVER ONTO THE TOP OF MY ARMS. THE LENGTH I COULD HAVE WORN IT AS A DRESS. THE MESH SHOWS YOUR BRA. THE BADGES SHRINK AND COME UNSTITCHED, THE CROWN IS A DISGRACE. PRESS STUDS LOOK DREADFUL WHEN I IRONED - REASON GIVEN BY ALEXANDRAS - SO YOU COULD WASH AT 70 - LABEL SAYS 40.

ADDS TO THE PROFESSIONAL IMAGE. LIKED BY HOSPITAL STAFF AND OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES. EMBROIDERY COULD BE BETTER (CHEAPLY DONE ON THE UNIFORM AT THE MOMENT) (EMBROIDERY ON DECON SHIRTS MUCH BETTER) SO IT CAN BE DONE.

MATERIAL TOO HEAVY, VERY HOT AND SWEATY. EMBROIDERY ON BACK OF SHIRT IRRITATING IF NO T SHIRT WORN. TOO SHORT ON S/S SHIRT KEPT COMING UNTUCKED WHEN BENDING DOWN. EMBROIDERY ON NHS BADGE ON FRONT OF SHIRT UNCLEAR TO READ. POCKETS LOOK UNFINISHED WITH SLANTED CUT. BETTER WITH OLD V SHAPE. FABRIC MESH UNDERNEATH ARMS SERVES NO PURPOSE. BADGE ON LEFT ARM SPLIT AT BOTTOM AFTER WASHING (ONLY ON ONE SHIRT)

EMBROIDERY ON REAR OF SHIRT NEVER IRONS FLAT AND PULLS SHIRT OUT OF SHAPE. DARK COLOUR OF SHIRT ALSO RUNS INTO LIGHT COLOURED EMBROIDERY WHEN WASHING. COLLAR NEEDS TO BE PROPERLY TAILORED AND STITCHED. ONE LARGE EMBROIDERED LAS LOGO ABOVE LEFT BREAST POCKET IS SUFFICIENT.

I HAVE CHOSEN NO BADGE ON THE SLEEVES BECAUSE I FELT THAT THE CREST BADGE ON THE CHEST WOULD BE ENOUGH, HOWEVER IF WE HAD TO HAVE A SLEEVE BADGE I WOULD SUGGEST LEFT ARM ONLY (LAS WITH OR WITHOUT NHS) I WOULD STRESS THAT THE QUALITY OF THE BADGES TRIALLED ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE, SOME HAVE GONE TO THREADS IN THE WASH AND VISUALLY THEY CHEAPEN THE WHOLE LOOK OF THE UNIFORM. AS FOR THE EMBROIDERY IT SHRINKS AND PULLS THE MATERIAL. THE COLLAR IS THE TYPE WE HAVE BEEN ASKING FOR FOR A LONG TIME, BUT IT DISAPPOINTS ME TO SEE THE WAY THESE HAVE BEEN DONE. ESSENTIALLY THIS IS A DRESS SHIRT WITH THE COLLAR PRESSED DOWN. THE SEAMS ARE VISIBLE, THESE AGAIN CHEAPEN THE LOOK. OTHER MAKES OF SHIRTS AND THOSE WORN BY OTHER SERVICES HAVE THE SAME COLLAR BUT MADE WITH NO VISIBLE SEAMS.

THE EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK IS GOOD, BUT THE QUALITY OF THE EXECUTION, PARTICULARLY ON THE BADGE IS POOR. THE LAS BADGE ON THE ARM IS PROBABLY UNNECESSARY, AND TENDS TO LOOK SHABBY WITH WASHING AND IRONING. FOR A PERSON OF MY HEIGHT, I FELT THAT THE SHIRTS WERE TOO LONG IN LENGTH AND SLEEVE. (I RARELY WEAR LONG SLEEVED FOR THIS REASON). THE MESH IS A GOOD IDEA, BUT LOOKS TERRIBLE AND IS TOO REVEALING. LESS REVEALING MESH WOULD BE ACCEPTABLE. EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK IS DIFFICULT TO IRON FLAT. THE SHIRTS ARE QUITE HOT IN WARM WEATHER.

GAP BETWEEN STUDS GAPES SO WOMENS SHIRTS NEED A BUST LINE DART. MESH UNDER ARMS MEANS I HAVE TO WEAR A T SHIRT HOWEVER HOT. SHIRTS FITS MEN, WOMEN HAVE A BUST!

MATERIAL TOO WARM FOR SUMMER WEAR

THE BADGES ON THE SLEEVE HAVE ALREADY STARTED PEELING APART. THE SHIRTS ARE VERY HARD TO IRON AND THE EMBROIDERY IS ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE TO IRON AND IS VERY ITCHY WHICH MEANS I HAD TO WEAR A T SHIRT UNDERNEATH WHICH WAS TOO HOT. I WOULD NOT WEAR THIS SHIRT.

THE SHIRTS I WAS GIVEN WERE TOO BIG (WIDE AND LONG). I GAVE TO ANOTHER MEMBER OF STAFF WHEN WE PICKED UP THE UNIFORM. I WAS PROMISED SOME IN MY SIZE BUT DID NOT RECEIVE THEM.

Shirt Comments

I WAS NEVER PROVIDED WITH THE RIGHT SIZE OF SHIRT DESPITE ASKING SEVERAL TIMES. I HAD TO BORROW L/S SHIRTS FROM ANOTHER UNIFORM TRIALLER. BADGES WERE CHEAP ANDN WERE FALLING APART AFTER FIRST WASH. BADGES MADE IRONING VERY HARD. STUDS ARE A DREADFUL IDEA AND CONSTANTLY BEING PULLED OPEN.

SHIRT FAR TOO SHORT. PREFER TAILS.

FELT SHIRTS WERE TOO THICK NEED A LIGHTER WEIGHT SHIRT.

EMBROIDERY TENDS TO SHRINK ON WASHING.

LAS EMBROIDERY ON BACK OF SHIRT PUCKERED DURING WASHING AND TOOK A LOT OF IRONING. NHS LOGO WAS OF POOR QUALITY, BEGAN TO FRAY ALREADY. SHIRT IS TOO SHORT AND IS ALWAYS HANGING OUT.

THE BADGES AND EMBROIDERY HAVE FRAYED BADLY AFTER ONLY 4-6 WASHES. THE BADGES AND EMBROIDERY IS A GOOD IDEA, BUT MAKE THE SHIRT MORE TIME CONSUMING TO IRON. LONDON AMBULANCE ACROSS THE BACK HAS GIVEN POSITIVE IMPRESSION, BUT DOES PUCKER WHEN WASHED. BADGES ON SLEEVE MAKE IRONING A PAIN.

DIDN'T THINK THE STUDS WOULD BE STURDY ENOUGH BUT PROVED WRONG, NOW THINK STUDS ARE MUCH BETTER THAN BUTTONS AS THEY DON'T FALL OFF. EMBROIDERY ON THE BACK OF THE SHIRTS AN ADDED EXPERIENCE THAT IS NOT NEEDED AND MAKES IRONING VERY DIFFICULT. BADGES ON THE SLEEVES LOOK OK WHEN NEW BUT AFTER A FEW WASHES AND IRONS THEY LOOK VERY TATTY AND THE EDGES BECOME WRINKLED. MESH UNDER THE ARMS NO GOOD WITHOUT T-SHIRT AND DOESN'T MAKE THE GARMENT ANY COOLER.

TOO HOT IN WARM CLIMATE.

LENGTH OF SHIRTS TRIALED ARE FAR TOO LONG. LONG SLEEVE SHIRTS ARE FAR TOO LONG, UNABLE TO WEAR THEM. STUD FASTENINGS ARE A BAD IDEA. NOT SECURE ENOUGH. AFTER IRONING OVER STUDS MARKS WERE LEFT ON MATERIAL.

EVEN AFTER APPROXIMATLEY 12 WASHES THERE IS A MARKED DISCOLOURATION AND AFTER REPEATED IRONING THE POPPERS SHOW THROUGH MAKING THE SHIRT LOOK VERY SCRUFFY. LAS BADGE IS OF A VERY LOW QUALITY.

LOGOS ON SLEEVES SHOULD BE HIGHER UP AND BETTER QUALITY
LAS EMBROIDERY ON THE FRONT OF SHIRTS SHOULD BE WITHOUT WORDING UNDERNEATH AND SLIGHTLY LARGER (LIKE OLDER ONES) - AT THE BACK IT SHOULD BE STITCHED ON SEPARATE FABRIC SO IT WOULD NOT CRUNCH UP WHEN WASHED (LIKE STAB VESTS).
HIDDEN POPS ARE NOT NEAT, AFTER A FEW WASHES AND IRONING GET DISCOLOURED CIRCLES OVER THEM AND IN LONG RUN LOOK HORRIBLE.

LAS EMBROIDERY ON THE REAR OF THE SHIRTS NOT NEEDED. IF WE ARE IN A PUBLIC PLACE WE SHOULD BE WEARING OUR HI-VIZ EQUIPMENT (STAB VEST) WHICH SHOWS WHO WE ARE.

I DON'T SEE THE POINT. AT AN INCIDENT OR ON CALLS, ALL STAFF SHOULD BE WEARING HI-VIZ OR BODY AMOUR WHICH IT IS WRITTEN ON.

THE QUALITY OF THE EMBROIDERY ON THE BADGE OF BREAST POCKET IS POOR AND UNREADABLE.

SHIRT WAS OF POOR QUALITY. COLLARS ARE RUBBISH AFTER 5 WEARS, THEY LOOK AS THOUGH I HAVE BEEN WEARING THEM FOR YEARS. BADGES BAD QUALITY FALLING APART.

OVERALL I THINK THE SHIRT COLOUR IS TOO DARK WHEN SEEN WITH TROUSERS AND STAB VEST. TOO PARAMILITARY LOOKING.

OVERALL I LIKED THE SHIRTS I HAVE SOME RESERVATIONS ABOUT THE MESH UNDERARMS. I FOUND STUDS BETTER THAN EXPECTED AND HAVE NO REAL PREFERRNCE ABOUT THE BADGES ON THE ARMS.

OVERALL THE EMBROIDERY WAS VERY POOR. VERY POOR SIZING IN EVERY SHOP I BUY A SHIRT I AM A MEDIUM, HOWEVER AN LAS SHIRT IN A MEDIUM IS LIKE A LARGE OR XLARGE. LUCKILY I WAS GIVEN 2 SMALL SHIRTS. POPPERS ARE POOR TO IRON AND LOOK CHEAP.

THE QUALITY OF EMBROIDERY ON BOTH THE FRONT AND THE REAR COULD BE IMPROVED.

SHIRT LENGTHS ARE SLIGHTLY TOO SHORT TO TUCK IN PULL OUT OVER THE WAIST. EMBROIDERY DIFFICULT TO IRON. PLEASE GET RID OF UNDERARM MESH.

Shirt Comments

I HAVE COMMENTED ON THE SHIRT FROM GENERAL OPINION BECAUSE I WAS UNABLE TO WEAR THE SHIRTS I WAS PROVIDED WITH AS THEY SWAMPED ME, AND NO MORE WERE AVAILABLE.

STUDS CAUSE MARKING AFTER IRONING. SHORT SLEEVES ARE TOO BAGGY AT THE ARM. MESH UNDERARMS LOOK LIKE RIP. EMBROIDERY PUCKERS AND DOES NOT IRON OUT. VERY POOR LAS CREST.

EMBROIDERY ON REAR OF SHIRTS SHRUNK ON WASHING. COULD WE FIND A FABRIC THAT IS EASY TO WASH AND EASY TO IRON OR NON IRON? THE UNIFORM CAN ONLY BE WORN ONCE DUE TO THE NATURE OF THE JOB, THEREFORE A FABRIC THAT CAN BE WASHED AND DRIED QUICKLY WOULD BE BETTER.

QUALITY OF EMBROIDERY TERRIBLE. EMBROIDERY ON BACK SHRUNK WHEN TUMBLE DRIED. I LIKE THE OPEN NECK STYLE BUT FOUND IT DIFFICULT TO IRON.

THE EMBROIDERED BADGE ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE CHEST LOOKS GOOD, BUT IS UNCOMFORTABLE WHEN NOT WEARING A T-SHIRT. A SUITABLE LINING SHOULD BE SEWN ONTO THE BACK OF THE BADGE TO PREVENT DISCOMFORT.

MATERIAL TOO WARM FOR SUMMER WEAR.
